At its July 8, 2016 meeting, the Commission voted unanimously to dismiss your complaint for failure to state an allegation of negligence or misconduct related to any forensic analysis. You complaint makes a general request for DNA testing that is beyond the Commission's jurisdiction. The Commission does not have the authority to issue an opinion related to the failure to conduct DNA testing or to order DNA testing in any criminal case.
