The Commission is in receipt of your complaint dated June 28, 2016. The Commission's jurisdiction is very limited and extends to complaints of professional negligence and/or misconduct on the part of forensic laboratories in the State of Texas.

After reviewing your complaint, staff sees no allegations concerning a forensic analysis that affected the outcome of your case. Your complaint appears to be against a hospital and law enforcement officials, neither of which fall under the Commission's authority.
