Dear Mr. Wilson:

At its February 10, 2017 meeting, the Commission unanimously dismissed your complaint, because it does not allege any particular issue with the forensic analysis of the gasoline in your case. The Commission requested the laboratory provide an explanation of the forensic analysis performed and the data underlying the positive finding for gasoline on the evidentiary item about which you have complained. Commissioners found the examiner's explanation satisfactory and the data supportive of the laboratory report's conclusions.
