Dear Mr. Alejandro:

At its February 10, 2017 meeting, the Commission voted unanimously to dismiss your complaint for failure to state an allegation of negligence or misconduct related to the forensic analysis in your case. Your complaint alleges the expert should have connected the shell casings to someone else's gun, an allegation over which the Commission has no jurisdiction. The analyst also did not affirmatively associate your weapon to the shell casings. Thus, there is no probative association for the Commission to examine.
