Dear Mr. Turner:

At its May 26, 2017 meeting, the Commission voted unanimously to dismiss your complaint because no allegation of professional negligence or misconduct was made against a forensic laboratory or analyst. The Commission's jurisdiction is over crime laboratories, and there is nothing in your complaint for this Commission to investigate.

Your allegations include your belief that you were wrongfully convicted, and that the trier of fact failed to afford sufficient weight to certain forensic results in your case including the lack of gunshot residue and inconclusive DNA mixture results. The Commission has no authority to intercede in legal proceedings and therefore cannot assist you with this aspect of your case. I have enclosed a list of innocence clinics operating in Texas should you wish submit your case to one for consideration.
