Dear Mr. Whitlock:

At its August 18, 2017 meeting the TFSC voted to dismiss your complaint for failure to state an allegation of negligence or misconduct in connection with a forensic analysis. At the time the analysis in your case was performed, flameless atomic absorption was an acceptable test for gunshot residue.

TFSC has jurisdiction only over forensic laboratories and the analysis performed within them. It cannot order new or additional testing of evidence nor can it intervene in matters of court such as admission or exclusion of evidence. These are matters best handled by your legal representative.

Should you need counsel, I have enclosed is a list of innocence clinics operating in the State of Texas if you wish to submit the facts of your case to them for consideration. Thank you and let me know if I may be of any additional assistance.
