This is to inform you that your complaint was dismissed by the Commission. Ms. Wilson's trial testimony was thoroughly reviewed by the Commission's general counsel and no inappropriate testimony was noted. The overall impression from her responses to attorneys' questions was that she could make no definitive statement as to whether the victim had or had not been sexually assaulted.

The Commission assumes conviction was therefore based on other evidence or legal grounds. I am enclosing a list of innocence clinics operating in the State of Texas should you wish to submit the facts of your case to them for consideration.
