


Status Update

JCIT Meeting November 30, 2018

Transaction Volume: 8/1/2018 to 10/31/2018





Summary

- Over 259k user accounts created as of 10/31/18
- EFM currently receiving~32,000 envelopes per day
 - ❖ 87.4% Civil
 - ❖ 12.6% Criminal
- State filing portal accounts for 82% of transactions; remaining 18% stem from commercial EFSP submissions



Summary

- ➤ 76% of courts live on eFileTexas are integrated w/ their Case Management Systems (502 out of 657)
- Integration progress with CMS providers:
 - 6 CMS providers have established One-Way integration
 - 7 CMS providers have established Two-Way integration


Returns by Reason – October 2018



Summary

- Top 10 most populous counties return reasons are similar to all other counties
- Number of Illegible / Unreadable returns could be reduced by the expansion of SelfHelp.eFileTexas
- 619 returns based on lack of redaction (not graphed)
- Over 14% returned back, due to filer mistakes
 - Wrong location
 - Incorrect Case Type / Filing Code

Summary

- *Top 10 most populous counties are trending less than the group average
- Return rates have declined since inception and continue to trend downward
- National average return for correction rate is ~8%




*Tracking of top most 10 populous counties began in September 2018

Responses in Under 24 Hours




Response rates are similar between courts of different sizes

Response rates do not include weekends and holidays


