Fourth Court of Appeals to Hear Oral Argument

The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral arguments in one appeal on Tuesday, February 12, 2019, beginning at 9:00 a.m., before the following panel of justices: Chief Justice Sandee Bryan Marion, Justice Patricia O. Alvarez, and Justice Liza A. Rodriguez.

The following case will be presented:

Williams v. State – In this appeal, this Court is being asked to consider twenty-three issues brought by Williams, including whether the trial court erred in denying Williams's request for a lesser-included instruction; whether the trial court erred in admitting voluminous Backpage ads; whether the trial court erred in failing to suppress evidence obtained as a result of a warrantless arrest of Williams and a warrantless search of his vehicle; and whether the trial court erred in not permitting Williams to introduce impeachment evidence against the complainant.

The oral arguments will be held in the Fourth Court's Courtroom, Cadena-Reeves Justice Center, Third Floor, 300 Dolorosa, San Antonio, Texas.
