

- Guardianship Specialty Courts

### **Modernizing Jurisdiction**

- Increase Civil Jurisdiction Floor:
- District Courts from \$200 to \$10,000
- Statutory County Courts from \$200 to \$5,000
- Justice Courts from \$10,000 to \$20,000

### **Business Courts**

 Create business court for complex litigation that is part of existing court structure







The civil justice system is a lot different than many perceive it to be.




The civil caseload in **Texas** has undergone a significant transition.






### More than 80% of caseload involves contracts and small claims.






### Civil filings increased in nearly every case category.








**Debt** cases increased significantly over the last 5 years and account for a large share of the courts' civil caseload.








From 2017-18, the number of **debt** cases in the **justice courts** rose by nearly 48,000 (29%).

88 percent of counties reported an increase in cases.




**Injury/damage** cases involving a **motor vehicle** have increased significantly, primarily in the district courts where there has been a 70% increase in the last 5 years.

## **Probate and guardianship** filings increased in all case categories except minor guardianships.





# After rising to an all-time high in 2017, the number of applications filed for involuntary **mental health** commitment declined by 4% in 2018.
