**ORDER DECLARING JULES DYLAN STUER A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT,
REQUIRING SECURITY, AND ISSUING A PREFILING ORDER AGAINST
JULES DYLAN STUER**

ON THIS DAY a hearing was conducted to determine whether Jules Dylan Stuer is a Vexatious Litigant, and whether he should be required to furnish security. The Court considered whether Jules Dylan Stuer should be made subject to a Prefiling Order. The Court, after examining the pleadings and evidence and all briefs and supplements submitted, together with legal authorities, and having considered the arguments of counsel and Jules Dylan Stuer, is of the opinion and determines that Jules Dylan Stuer is a Vexatious Litigant in accordance with Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code § 11.054, that he should be required to furnish security in accordance with Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code § 11.055, and that a Prefiling Order should be issued against Jules Dylan Stuer in accordance with Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code §§ 11.101, 11.102.

It is therefore ORDERED that Defendant Susan Duesler's Motion for an Order Determining Plaintiff Jules Dylan Stuer to be a Vexatious Litigant and Requiring Security is GRANTED.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that Jules Dylan Stuer is declared a vexatious litigant pursuant to Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code § 11.054(2)(B).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Jules Dylan Stuer must provide security by obtaining a bond in the amount of ~~\$101,000.00~~ ^{\$35,000.00} no later than March 30, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. for the benefit of Defendant Duesler to assure payment of her reasonable expenses, including costs and attorneys' fees, incurred in connection with this suit. *(F)*

*This bond amount does not establish the attorneys' fees to be awarded in the event the case is **

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Court will dismiss this litigation with prejudice if Jules Dylan Stuer does not provide the security within the designated time period.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a **PRE-FILING ORDER** be and hereby is issued against Jules Dylan Stuer and that Jules Dylan Stuer is prohibited from filing, *pro se*, any new litigation in a court to which the order applies without first obtaining written permission from the local administrative judge strictly in accordance with Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code § 11.102. Jules Dylan Stuer is further advised that, pursuant to Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code § 11.101(b), a person who disobeys a Prefiling Order is subject to Contempt of Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the District Clerk of Dallas County, Texas, as required by Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code § 11.104(a), shall provide the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System a copy of this ORDER not later than the 30 days after the date this ORDER is signed.
