**ORDER**

**PER CURIAM**

Appellant T. L. H. filed her notice of appeal on April 13, 2020. The appellate record was complete April 27, 2020, making appellant's brief due May 18, 2020. On May 11, 2020, and May 21, 2020, counsel for appellant filed motions for extension of time to file appellant's brief.

The rules of judicial administration accelerate the final disposition of appeals from suits for termination of parental rights. *See* Tex. R. Jud. Admin. 6.2(a) (providing 180 days for court's final disposition). The accelerated schedule constrains this Court's leeway in granting extensions. In this instance, we will grant the May 21, 2020 motion and dismiss as moot the May 11, 2020 motion. We order Karen J. Langsley to file appellant's brief no later than June 1, 2020. If the brief is not filed by that date, counsel may be required to show cause why she should not be held in contempt of court.

It is ordered on May 28, 2020.
