At its June 12, 2020 quarterly meeting, the Commission reviewed the referenced self-disclosure. Based on the corrective actions taken by the laboratory, including remedial training for the analyst, review of the analyst's cases from the previous six months with no issues identified, and changes made to the seized drugs technical review policy to include review of raw data for any case that will be reported as "no controlled substance or dangerous drug identified", the Commission concluded no further action is necessary at this time.
