ORDER OF DISMISSAL AND PREFILING ORDER

On July 31, 2020, the Court entered an order declaring Plaintiff pro se Norman L. Agnew to be a vexatious litigant pursuant to Chapter 11 of the Civil Practice and Remedies Code.
