Dear Mr. Curry,

At its quarterly meeting on January 29, 2021, the Forensic Science Commission (“Commission”) voted to dismiss the referenced complaint because the laboratory agreed to reanalyze the evidence, and both the Harris County Public Defender’s Office and the Harris County District Attorney’s Office Conviction Integrity Unit are engaged in the process. While a review of the data confirmed you could not be excluded as a contributor at certain markers, the testimony of the analyst regarding the statistical rarity of your known DNA profile did not provide any useful information regarding the (partial) profile obtained from the evidence.
