It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that, pursuant to Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code § 11.056, this Court will dismiss Plaintiff's claims against MIC in this case if Plaintiff does not furnish the security within the time set by this Order.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that, pursuant to Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code § 11.101, Plaintiff is prohibited from filing, pro se, a new litigation in any other Texas court without permission of the appropriate local administrative judge.
