At its October 25, 2019 quarterly meeting, the Commission voted to dismiss the referenced complaint because there was no credible allegation of negligence or misconduct with respect to the forensic analysis at issue in the case. The request made for re-testing of evidence should be directed to your legal representative or the court of competent jurisdiction. The Commission has no authority to order forensic testing.
