Dear Mr. Davis,

This letter is to let you know that the referenced complaints were dismissed by TFSC staff. The bases for dismissal are outlined below.

Complaint No. 21.60 was dismissed because the TFSC has no jurisdiction over subpoena compliance. This is a question for the court to address. Furthermore, subpoena compliance is not a forensic analysis of physical evidence for the purpose of determining its connection to a criminal action. The TFSC has jurisdiction over allegations of professional negligence or misconduct related to the forensic analysis of physical evidence.

Complaint No. 21.61 was dismissed because there were no allegations of professional negligence or misconduct concerning the forensic analysis of physical evidence. Issues related to the identity of an individual suspect are outside the jurisdiction of the TFSC.
