Dear Mr. Johnson,

At its October 22, 2021 quarterly meeting, the Commission voted to dismiss the referenced complaint. Commission staff acquired analytical reports and trial transcripts of analyst testimony for this case and the case that was the subject of your complaint no. 20.39. In both cases, commissioners found the general allegations of inaccurate test results and false trial testimony concerning ABO blood typing to be unsupported by the records.

Pursuant to your letter request to examine the footwear impression evidence and related trial testimony in the 20.39 case, the Commission obtained and reviewed all relevant material. No irregularities with the analysis were noted, and trial testimony was not found to be false or misleading.

The Commission now considers these matters closed and will take no more action absent any new material information. Thank you.
