Dear Mr. Fuller,

At its quarterly meeting on October 22, 2021, the TFSC voted to dismiss the referenced complaint and refer it to the Dallas County Conviction Integrity Unit. The SWIFS laboratory report submitted with the complaint clearly stated that the weapon involved in the incident was non-functional. The TFSC's jurisdiction extends only to the forensic analysis itself which was appropriate.

Allegations that the laboratory "allowed the Dallas County Criminal District Attorney to make a false report or misleading assertion about ballistic evidence" is a legal question for the Court and is outside this commission's jurisdiction to consider.
