Public Safety Report System Monthly Statistics Guide

The monthly report includes data for defendants for whom bail was set or denied following arrest and any bond type modifications.

SB6 Section 71.0351(a)(1)(A-C) requires the reporting of the number of defendants for each category of offense, the number of personal bonds, and the number of surety or cash bonds. This is information is captured from the Bail Form information submitted through the PSRS.

The report contains data from completed bail forms for the corresponding location and reporting month.
