Dear Mr. Williams,

The referenced complaint was dismissed by TFSC staff for lack of jurisdiction. As stated on the instruction sheet sent with the complaint form “...the term ”forensic analysis” **does not include** the portion of an autopsy conducted by a medical examiner or other forensic pathologist who is a licensed physician.”

While a forensic analysis performed in conjunction with an autopsy, such as toxicology for example, may be within the TFSC’s jurisdiction, the autopsy itself and any conclusions regarding cause and manner of death are not. Complaints concerning licensed physicians should be made to the Texas Medical Board. Enclosed is one of their complaint forms should you choose to file a complaint with that entity against the physician who performed the autopsy in your case.
