## ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO DECLARE PLAINTIFF A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT

- 1. - 2. If Plaintiff does not furnish security within the time limit set by this Order, the Court will dismiss this suit with prejudice against Plaintiff.
- 3. This suit will remain in abatement until Plaintiff complies with this Order or until it is dismissed by further order of this Court.
- 4. Plaintiff must not file as a pro se party any new litigation in a court in Texas against Defendant Memorial Hermann Health System and its agents, directors, officers, employees, heirs, assigns, and attorneys without first obtaining permission from the appropriate local administrative judge as required by Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code section 11.102(a).
- 5. As required by Texas Civil Procedure & Remedies Code section 11.104, the Court Clerk will provide a copy of this Order to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System.
