Dear Mr. Carrio,

This letter is to inform you that the referenced complaint was dismissed by TFSC staff for failure to state an allegation of negligence or misconduct related to a forensic analysis of physical evidence in your case. As the state oversight body for accredited crime laboratories and their licensed analysts, the TFSC's jurisdiction extends only those entities and not to any of the subjects of your complaint.

The TFSC has no jurisdiction over attorneys, law enforcement, judges or licensed medical personnel. Your allegations against a district attorney and a police department therefore cannot be considered by this Commission. Additionally, the TFSC has no authority over autopsies conducted by a medical examiner or any other forensic pathologist who is a licensed physician.
