ORDER ON DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO DECLARE PLAINTIFF A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT

DENIES the Motion &

GRANTS the motion, declares Plaintiff a vexatious litigant and orders as follows:

- 1. Plaintiff must furnish security for the benefit of Defendants, by posting a surety bond with the court clerk in the amount of \$\frac{7500}{\text{ in the form of cash}}{\text{ or cashiers check}} \text{ by } \frac{9/5/2023}{\text{ . The security is to}} \text{ assure payment to the defendant for reasonable expenses, including their court costs and attorney fees, should the case be dismissed on the merits.
- 2. If Plaintiff does not furnish security within the time limit set by this order, the Court will dismiss this suit with prejudice against Plaintiff.
- 3. This suit will remain in abatement until Plaintiff complies with this order or until it is dismissed by further order of this Court.
- 4. Plaintiff must not file as a pro se party any new litigation in a court in Texas against any party without first obtaining permission from the appropriate local administrative judge as required by Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code section 11.102(a).
