
**AMENDED ORDER ON DEFENDANT I.Q. DATA INTERNATIONAL, INC'S MOTION
TO DECLARE PLAINTIFF CHARLOTTE CARROLL A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT**

~~On this day,~~ ^{on} the Court considered Defendant I.Q. Data International, Inc.'s Motion to Declare Plaintiff Charlotte Carroll a Vexatious Litigation (the "Motion") pursuant to Chapter 11 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code which was filed on September 27, 2023. The Court, having ^{and having received the order} considered this Motion, response, reply, and arguments of counsel, if any, finds that Plaintiff Charlotte ^{denying Ms. Carroll's amended motion to} ~~Carroll~~ ^{recuse} meets the criteria of a vexatious litigant under Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code § 11.054, and that the Motion should be, and hereby is, in all things **GRANTED**. It is therefore,

ORDERED as follows:

1. Plaintiff Charlotte Carroll is hereby declared a vexatious litigant pursuant to Chapter 11 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code and she is prohibited from filing any new suit in Texas as a *pro se* litigant without first obtaining permission from a local administrative judge.
2. Plaintiff Charlotte Carroll must post security in the amount of \$5,000 to assure that Defendant I.Q. Data International, Inc. will recover reasonable expenses, including costs and attorney's fees, if Plaintiff Charlotte Carroll's case is dismissed on the merits. This proceeding is stayed until such payment is made.
3. If Plaintiff Charlotte Carroll fails to furnish security within fourteen (14) days of this Order, this case will be dismissed *with* prejudice to the refiling of same.
4. As required by § 11.104 of the Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code, the court clerk will provide a copy of this Order to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System.
