If you already have an account on re:SearchTX or eFileTexas, start at **Step 4**.


1. Go to <https://research.txcourts.gov> and click on **Register**.


2. Enter your name, email address, a password (must be at least 8 characters long) and select the appropriate account type. Click on **Register** when complete.


6. On the Main Menu, click on **Advanced Search**


