Fourth Court of Appeals to Hear Oral Argument

The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral argument in a consolidated permissive appeal on Thursday, May 15, 2025, beginning at 10:00 a.m., before the following panel of justices: Justice Lori Massey Brissette, Justice Adrian A. Spears II, and Justice Velia J. Meza.

The following appeal will be presented:

In *Jemadari Chinau Williams v. State*, No. 04-20-00486-CR, which is on remand from the Texas Court of Criminal Appeals, appellant argues he suffered egregious harm because the jury charge failed to require unanimity on each element of one of the six alleged aggravated promotion of prostitution statutory methods, which appellant contends constitute separate offenses and not manner and means of committing one offense. Appellant further argues the trial court erred in denying his motion to quash because the indictment used undefined terms of indeterminate or variable meaning, and more specific pleading was required pursuant to *State v. Mays*, 967 S.W.2d 404 (Tex. Crim. App. 1998).

The oral argument will be held in the Kerr County Commissioners' Courtroom, which is on the first floor of the Kerr County Courthouse, 700 Main Street, Kerrville, Texas, 78028.
