Fourth Court of Appeals to Hear Oral Argument

The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral argument in one appeal on Thursday, May 22, 2025, beginning on 9:00 a.m., before the following panel of justices: Chief Justice Rebeca C. Martinez, Justice Adrian A. Spears II, and Justice H. Todd McCray.

The following case will be presented:

T.H., **a juvenile**, appeals from the trial court's denial of his pretrial application for writ of habeas corpus following a mistrial. The issues are whether the Double Jeopardy Clause of the Fifth Amendment to the United States Constitution bars retrial based on T.H.'s assertions (1) that the prosecutor goaded him into requesting a mistrial and (2) that the prosecutor intentionally violated the trial court's limine order with the intent to avoid the possibility of acquittal.
