On September 11, 2025, Petitioner requested from Respondent certain assigned judge certification and oath of office records related to a judge subject to assignment by Respondent in Respondent's administrative judicial region. On September 25, 2025, Respondent disclosed to Petitioner, via certified mail return receipt requested, documents responsive to the request. On October 2, 2025, Petitioner filed its petition for review.¹

Where judicial records responsive to a Rule 12 request are provided to a requestor, Rule 12 is satisfied. *See* Rule 12 Dec. Nos. 23-004, 23-006. Respondent produced 18 pages of documents responsive to Petitioner's request, sent by certified mail return receipt requested to the address provided by Petitioner and within the Rule 12.6(b) timeframe for disclosure. Respondent has complied with its Rule 12 obligations and the appeal is dismissed.

¹ In its reply to the petition, Respondent provided USPS tracking history connected to the certified mail showing that the package sent to Petitioner went out for delivery on September 29 and that notice was left at the address alerting Petitioner of the package. On October 14, the package was listed as unclaimed and returned to the Respondent.
