Fourth Court of Appeals to Hear Oral Argument

The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral argument in one appeal on Thursday, February 26, 2026, beginning at 10:00 a.m., before the following panel of justices: Chief Justice Rebeca C. Martinez, Justice Irene Rios, and Justice Lori I. Valenzuela.

City of San Antonio; San Antonio Police Department; Joe Vidal, Individually and in His Official Capacity; and Daniel Moynihan, Individually and in His Official Capacity, No. 04-25-00351-CV: In this appeal, appellants challenge the trial court's denial of their motion for summary judgment, which argued that appellees' takings, ultra vires, and declaratory judgment claims are barred by governmental immunity.
