FINAL ORDER IN SUIT TO MODIFY PARENT-CHILD RELATIONSHIP

On February 9, 2026, the Court heard this case.

Appearances

Petitioner, TRENT GARRETT, appeared in person through attorney of record, John Hennan of HENNAN | CULP, PLLC, and announced ready.

Respondent, Pro Se, TEREZA KACEROVA, filed pleadings and made a general appearance. Respondent received notice of the hearing, was ordered to appear for the hearing, and failed to appear. Respondent defaulted.

Jurisdiction

The Court, after examining the record and the evidence and argument of counsel, finds that it has jurisdiction of this case and of all the parties and that no other court has continuing, exclusive jurisdiction of this case. All persons entitled to citation were properly cited.

Jury

A jury was waived, and all questions of fact and of law were submitted to the Court.

Record

The record of testimony was duly reported by the visiting court reporter, Dora Canizales, for the 455th Judicial District Court.

Vexatious Litigant Finding

The Court FINDS TEREZA KACEROVA is a vexatious litigant under Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code § 11.054(2).

IT IS ORDERED that TEREZA KACEROVA is subject to a prefiling order under Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code § 11.101.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that TEREZA KACEROVA is prohibited from filing, pro se, new litigation without seeking the permission of the local administrative judge. Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code § 11.102.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that TEREZA KACEROVA shall furnish security in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) before filing any further motions or request for relief in any proceeding. Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code. § 11.055.

Enforcement by Contempt and Sanctions

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any attempt by TEREZA KACEROVA to file pleadings in violation of this Order may constitute contempt of court and may subject her to appropriate sanctions, including fines, attorney's fees, and other relief authorized by law.

The Court expressly reserves jurisdiction to impose additional filing restrictions if Respondent continues to engage in abusive litigation practices.

Attorney's Fees

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that good cause exists to award TRENT GARRETT judgment in the amount of \$187,777.61 (one hundred eighty-seven thousand, seven hundred seventy-seven dollars and sixty-one cents) for reasonable and necessary attorney's fees, court costs, and expenses incurred by TRENT GARRETT in connection with this modification suit, with

IT IS ORDERED that all relief requested in this case and not expressly granted is denied. This Final Order supersedes any and all prior final orders entered in this cause and between the parties and child of this suit.
