**ORDER ON DEFENDANT RPM LIVING, LLC'S MOTION TO DECLARE
PLAINTIFFS PURNELL WILLIAMS AND ANGELA WILLIAMS VEXATIOUS
LITIGANTS, TO REQUIRE FURNISHMENT OF SECURITY, AND TO PROHIBIT
FILING OF NEW LITIGATION WITHOUT JUDICIAL PERMISSION
AS TO PURNELL WILLIAMS**

On the date indicated below, the Court heard Defendant RPM Living, LLC's Motion to Declare Plaintiffs Purnell Williams and Angela Williams Vexatious Litigants, to Require Furnishment of Security, and to Prohibit Filing of New Litigation without Judicial Permission ("Motion"). After reviewing the filings, exhibits, and arguments of counsel, if any, the Court finds Plaintiff Purnell Williams is a Vexatious Litigant pursuant to Section 11.054 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code.

It is hereby ORDERED that Defendant RPM Living, LLC's Motion to Declare Plaintiffs Purnell Williams and Angela Williams Vexatious Litigants, to Require Furnishment of Security, and to Prohibit Filing of New Litigation without Judicial Permission is **GRANTED** as to Purnell Williams and **DENIED** as to Angela Williams.

It is further ORDERED that Purnell Williams is declared a Vexatious Litigant pursuant to Section 11.054 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code and shall be placed on the Texas Judicial Branch List of Vexatious Litigants Subject to a Prefiling Order.

It is further ORDERED that, pursuant to Section 11.101 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code, Purnell Williams is prohibited from filing, pro se, new litigation in this State without permission from the appropriate local administrative judge in each new litigation. The clerk of court shall forward a copy of this order to the Office of Court Administration pursuant to section 11.104 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code.

It is further ORDERED that Plaintiff Purnell Williams be required to deposit into the Travis County court registry the amount of \$5,000.00 (the “Required Security”) on or before thirty (30) days from the date of this order. Failure by Plaintiff Purnell Williams to timely furnish the Required Security by the deadline set by this order shall result in the dismissal with prejudice of the claims brought by Plaintiff Purnell Williams in the current litigation.

It is further ORDERED that, pursuant to Section 11.052 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code, the current litigation is and shall remain stayed until ten (10) days after Defendant receives written confirmation that Plaintiff Purnell Williams has furnished the Required Security to the court registry.
