ORDER ON DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO DECLARE PLAINTIFF A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT

On June 20th, 2006 the Court considered Defendant's Motion to Declare Plaintiff a Vexatious Litigant. After reviewing the evidence and considering the arguments, the Court finds that the Motion should be **GRANTED**.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, Plaintiff must furnish security for the benefit of Defendant, Victor David Huhem, by posting a surety bond with the court clerk in the amount of \$15,000.00 by July 31st, 2006. The security is to assure payment to the Defendant for reasonable expenses, including his court costs and attorney fees, should the case be dismissed on the merits.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

1. If plaintiff does not furnish security within the time limit set by this order, the Court will dismiss this suit with prejudice against Plaintiff;
2. This suit will remain in abatement until plaintiff complies with this order or until it is dismissed by further order of this Court;
3. Plaintiff must not file as a pro se party any new litigation in a court in Texas against Defendants without first obtaining permission from the appropriate local administrative judge as required by Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code section 11.102(a);
4. Plaintiff is required to obtain leave of court before filing any new motions (including

dispositive motions, motions for reconsideration, or sanctions-related relief) or amended pleadings in this action, and before initiating any new action in this Court against these Defendants or their affiliates, arising out of the events underlying this case, for a period of 24 months;

~~5. Defendants are entitled to recover their attorney's fees from Plaintiff in the amount of \$ _____~~

6. As required by Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code section 11.104, the court clerk will provide a copy of this order to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System.
