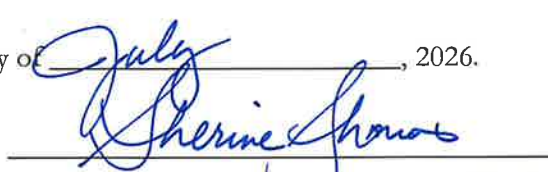

ORDER

On this date, the Court considered Defendant Eric Guerrero's Motion To Declare Plaintiff Jewell Thomas a Vexatious Litigant. The Court finds Plaintiff is a vexatious litigant pursuant to section 11.054 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code. Plaintiff is hereby ordered to furnish security in the amount of \$ 100.00 by September 1, 2026 to proceed in this case. Failure to timely furnish security may result in dismissal of this suit.

Pursuant to section 11.101 of the Civil Practice and Remedies Code, the Court further orders that Plaintiff be prohibited from filing new litigation in any court in this State without permission from a local administrative judge in each new litigation. The clerk of the court shall forward a copy of this order to the Office of Court Administration pursuant to section 11.104 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code.
