Fourth Court of Appeals to Hear Oral Argument

The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral arguments in one appeal on Wednesday, November 5, 2014, beginning at 9:00 a.m., before the following panel of justices: Justice Rebeca C. Martinez, Justice Patricia O. Alvarez, and Justice Luz Elena D. Chapa.

The following case will be presented:

John Christopher Dominguez v. The State of Texas - John Christopher Dominguez appeals his convictions for aggravated kidnapping and sexual assault of a child, complaining that the trial court erred by admitting testimony regarding alleged extraneous offenses and by sentencing him to a term of 60 years for the aggravated kidnapping offense.

The Fourth Court of Appeals will hear oral arguments in one appeal on Thursday, November 6, 2014, beginning at 9:00 a.m., before the following panel of justices: Chief Justice Catherine Stone, Justice Karen Angelini, and Justice Marialyn Barnard.

The following case will be presented:

Enrique Lopez d/b/a Maternidad La Piedad v. Marina Edith Osuna, Individually and as Next Friend for Sarai Edith Gonzalez and Benito Gonzalez Cantu - This is an accelerated appeal arising out of a trial court's order denying a motion to dismiss based on a failure to file an expert report in a health care liability matter. In this appeal, appellant contends the trial court erred in denying his motion to dismiss because appellees' suit involved a health care liability claim, mandating the timely filing of an expert report pursuant to section 74.351 of the Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code.

The oral arguments will be held in the Fourth Court's Courtroom, Caden-Reeves Justice Center, Third Floor, 300 Dolorosa, San Antonio, Texas.
