AMENDED ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO DECLARE PLAINTIFF FREDERICK C. FERMIN A VEXATIOUS LITIGANT

On March 13, 2015, came to be heard Defendant Financial Freedom Senior Funding Corporation's Motion to Declare Plaintiff Frederick C. Fermin a Vexatious Litigant. The Court, having considered the motion, the pleadings on file, and argument of counsel, finds that the motion is meritorious and should be granted. It is therefore,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant's Motion to Declare Plaintiff a Vexatious Litigant is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER DECLARED that Plaintiff Frederick C. Fermin is a vexatious litigant.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Frederick C. Fermin is prohibited from filing as a pro se litigant any litigation in the State of Texas without the permission of a local administrative judge who first reviews said litigation, pursuant to section 11.102 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code, and determines that the litigation has merit and has not been filed for the purpose of harassment.

As required by Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code section 11.104, the court clerk will provide a copy of this order to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System.

As the Court has already granted Defendant's Motion for Summary Judgment, this Order disposes of all remaining claims and parties.
